

## Checklist: What do I need for my procedure?

Your insurance card(s).



- Driver's License or Photo ID.
- A list of your current medications.
- Co-pay or deductible, as determined by your insurance company.
- Leave valuables and jewelry at home.
- Wear comfortable, loose fitting clothes.
- Plan to arrive at the center one hour prior to the procedure.



You should expect a stay of two to three hours total.



Bring the name and phone number of the person (must be 16 years or older with a valid driver's license) who will be taking you home. You will not be permitted to drive, take a taxi alone, or leave the center without an adult chaperone.

You must be 18 years old or over to have a procedure. If you are an adult who is unable to sign the consent, you must have someone with you who is authorized to sign on your behalf.
